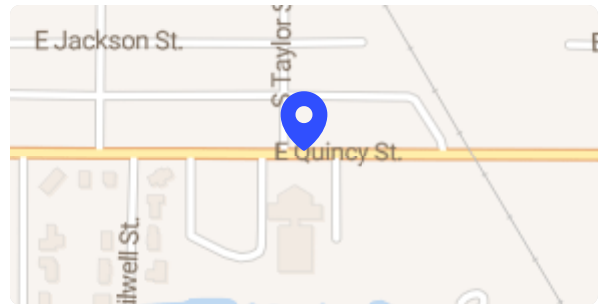
Carl Rousey, 76 of Pittsburg, KS formerly of Berryville, AR died Saturday July 16, 2016 at his home in Pittsburg.

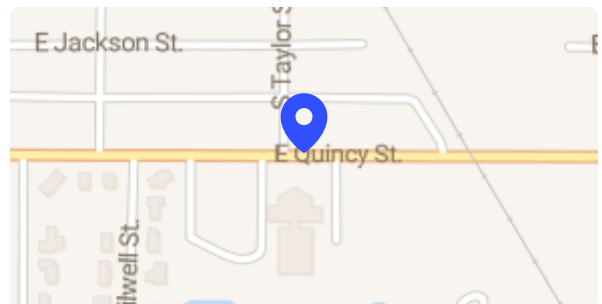
