Danny Howard Hickman 54, of Pittsburg, KS died 3:30am Sunday December 4, 2016 working for Kansas City Southern in Siloam Springs, Arkansas of an apparent heart attack.

Danny was born February 16, 1962 in Frontenac, KS the son of Byron Howard and Evelyn Irlene (Thomas) Hickman. He was a lifelong resident of the area and a graduate of Frontenac High School in 1980. He later attended Drafting School at Pittsburg State University and later Railroad Conductors School at Kansas City Southern.

On January 26, 1990 Danny married Deborah Ann Armstrong in Frontenac, KS; she survives at the home.

Danny has worked the last 12 years as a Conductor for the Kansas City Southern Railroad. In his earlier years he worked in residential construction in the Pittsburg area.

Danny was a former member of the Frontenac United Methodist Church in Frontenac, KS. He was a member of the Shrine; a Mason; and he will be most remembered as a man that enjoyed being the center of attention and making people laugh.

Additional survivors include his children Cody Hickman and wife Sandy of Frontenac, KS and Katie Hickman of Uniontown, KS; brother Tony, 2 sisters; several neices and nephews; father-in-law and mother-in-law Bob Armstrong and wife Peggy of Coffeyville, KS; grandchildren Ollie Hickman, Lundun Hickman and Fenix Hickman.

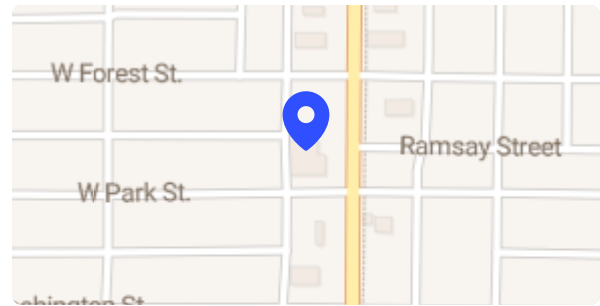

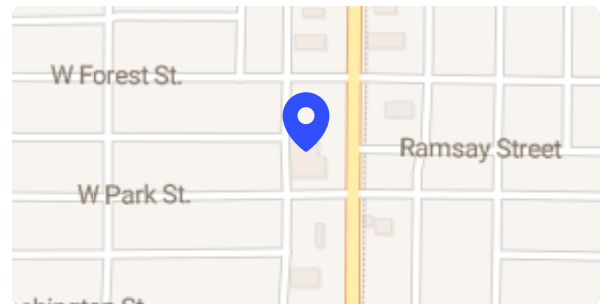

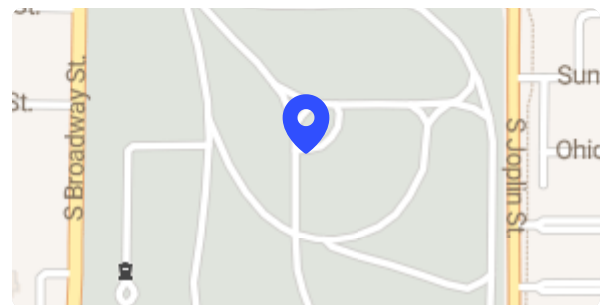
