PITTSBURG, KS – Martin A. “Marty” Cook, 53, died April 22, 2017 at his home.

He was born January 23, 1964 in Chanute, KS the son of Dale and Shirley Carstedt Cook. He had been a resident of Pittsburg since 1983, moving from Chanute. He graduated from Chanute High School, attended Neosho County Community College for one year and graduated from the Automotive Technology Department at Pittsburg State University.

He married Karen L. Conant on August 2, 1986 in Chanute. She survives at the home in Pittsburg.

Mr. Cook was a mechanic, working at Kings Automotive, Molle Automotive and for the USD 250 Transportation Department the past three years.

He was an avid hunter and fisherman, was very involved in car restoration, and a avid PSU Football Fan.

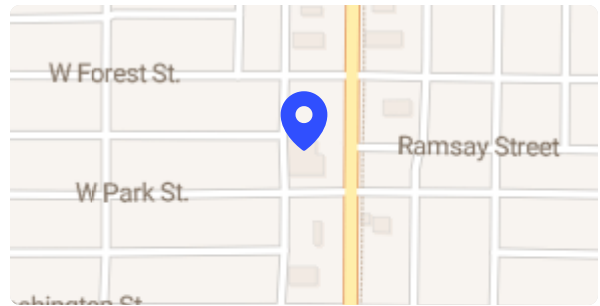

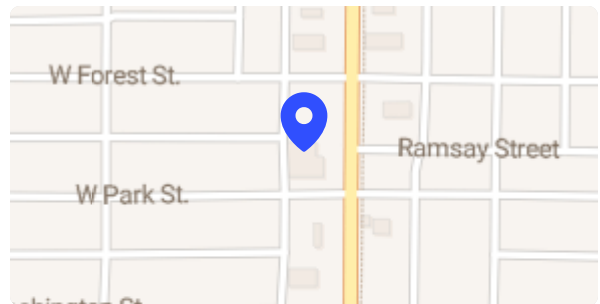
