Everett Marvin Brummett 89, of Mindenmines, MO died 3:39am Wednesday September 27, 2017 at his home following an illness.

Marvin was born November 26, 1927 in Rich Hill, MO the son of E.L. Sonny and Blanche (Prine) Brummett. He was a lifelong resident of the area and a graduate of Mindenmines High School in 1945.

On October 20, 1946 Marvin married Lucille Victoria Lucietta in Pittsburg, KS; she preceded him in death on April 22, 2014. Marvin worked for W.S. Dickey Clay in Pittsburg, KS; Kennett Paint and Wallpaper and later a self-employed contractor in Pittsburg, KS.

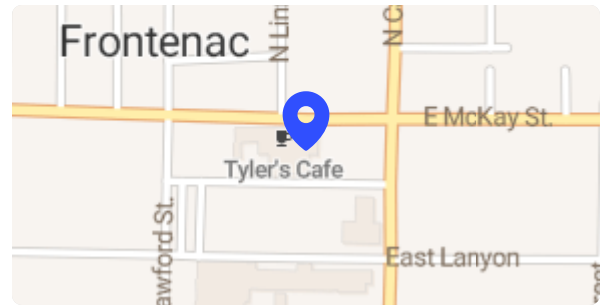

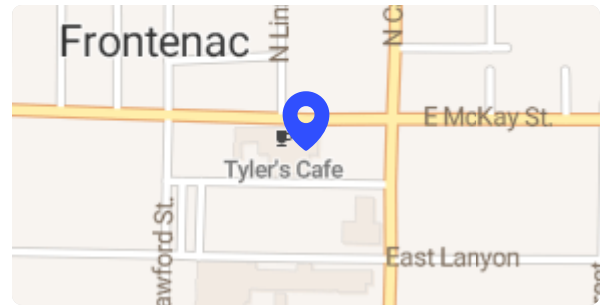

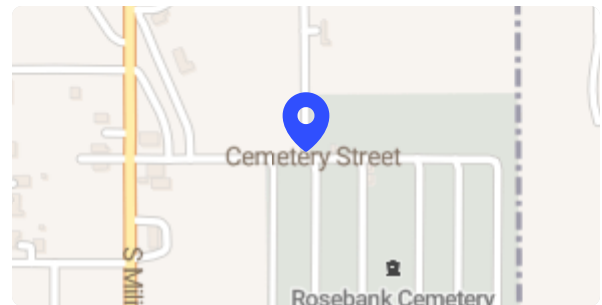
