Georgia May McCullough, 83, of Frontenac, Kansas, formerly of Scammon and West Mineral, died on Friday, December 13, 2019 at Medicalodges Frontenac.

She was born August 15, 1936 in Miami, Oklahoma, the daughter of George and Gertrude (Washington) Richardson. Georgia was a 1954 graduate of West Mineral High School and a member of the Scammon Presbyterian Church.

Georgia married Tommy Jo McCullough on December 31, 1954, they later divorced.

She worked as a clerk in the Cherokee County District Court office and retired after 25 years of service. Georgia was a 50 year member of the Order of the Eastern Star. She formerly served on the West Mineral High School reunion committee and the Hosey Hill cemetery board.

Georgia was a very proud “Nana” and was a faithful follower of all her grandkids school and sport activities.

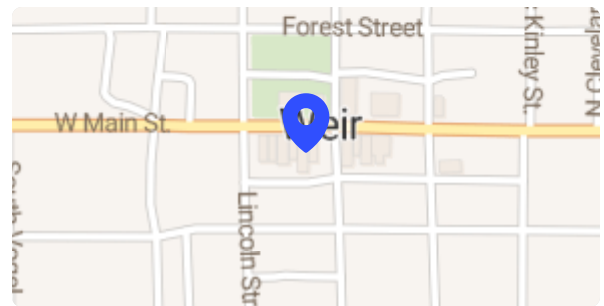

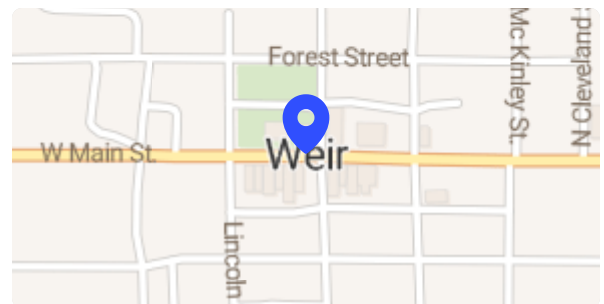

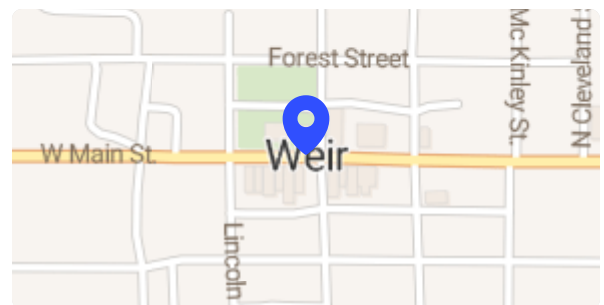
