Rodger was born September 14, 1942 in Garden City, KS the son of Frank B. and Pauline R. (Smith) Green. Rodger grew up in Western Kansas and graduated from Bunker Hill High School. After high school Rodger served in the Army for 2 years from 1960-1962. Rodger worked at the Chautauqua County Courthouse in Sedan, KS for 30 years as Director of Maintenance. Following retirement, 2 years ago Rodger moved to Pittsburg, KS to be near his daughter and grandchildren. Rodger was an ordained minister and practiced jail ministry for many years at the Chautauqua County Jail in Sedan, KS. Rodger was a talented artist and was able to paint and draw just about anything. He also enjoyed gardening, fishing and mowing. He was always willing to lend a hand and enjoyed helping others. He was a beloved member of the community. He attended and was a member of the Meadowside Baptist Church in Pittsburg.

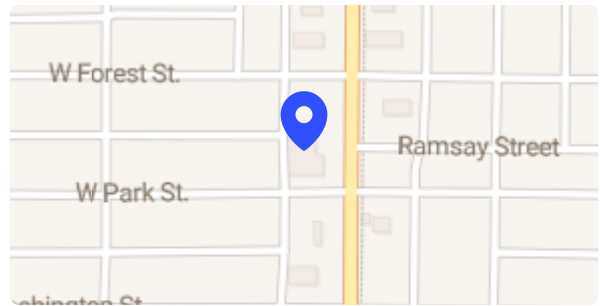
