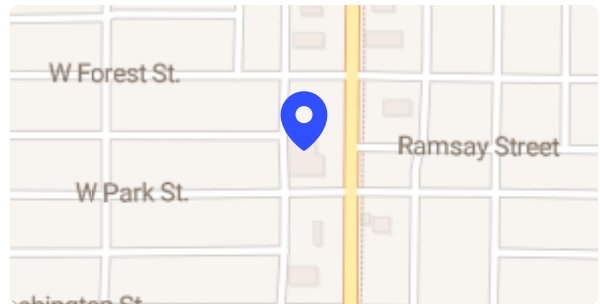

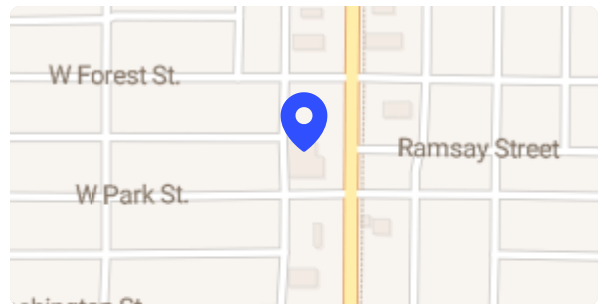

I remember helping you and Dad in our big garden, watering our flowers in the evening and ironing Dad's and Kenny's clothes. I helped cook yellow squash for dinner many of times. We did dishes, I helped you can tomatoes and make jelly. I learned a lot from you to become a housewife when I was 19. You and Dad were there for my children as they grew.
