# Clinton Lyle Hurt

**C**linton Lyle Hurt, 74, passed away on August 9th after suffering complications with Cancer and Kidney disease.

He was born to Newton Holder Hurt and Else Ella Brigance in Waldron, Arkansas.

The family settled in the KC metro where he attended Turner High School.

Following this, he attended and graduated from PSU where he received a Bachelors and Masters degree in Art and a Bachelor's degree in Psychology.

After graduation, he taught high school art in Kansas city and later continued on to become a Juvenile and adult probation officer in Crawford County which jumpstarted his employment as both a

Court Services officer, and later a Court Administrator in Southeast Kansas.

In 1968, Clinton met and married Nancy Angel and they had 2 children, Jason and Abby.

Survivors include his wife Nancy Angel Hurt, of Pittsburg, KS; Daughter Abby Hurt of Lenexa, KS, grandson, Greg Hurt of Pittsburg, KS, sister Fern Hurt of Kansas City, KS and Nephew Neil Goodman of Kansas City, KS.

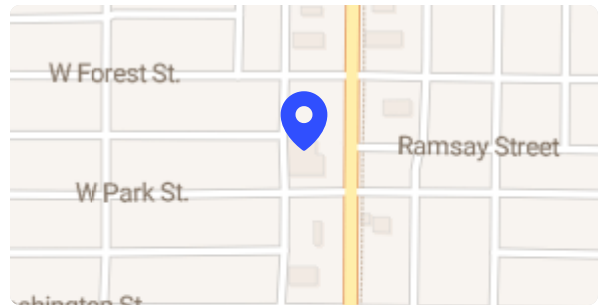
