Dwight Wesley McDonald, age 69, formerly of Frontenac, KS, passed away at his home in Seneca, MO on March 24, 2024.

He was born on May 7th, 1954 to Marlin and Mary (Mulligan) McDonald in Frontenac, KS. Twenty five years later in 1979 he exchanged vows with Pamela Fournet.

Dwight dedicated many years of his life as a terminal manager for a trucking company before happily embracing retirement. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, and was a member of the Warren's Branch Baptist Church. His love for music was evident, often filling the home with country western tunes such as Hank Williams. He was a vivid story teller always telling jokes and offhand comments spreading laughter wherever he went.
